

UF Health south campus construction

Phase 2: February 2015-Spring 2017

Please note changes to roadways and parking

Starting Jan. 26, vehicle access to the UF Health Shands Cancer Hospital via Archer Road and Circle of Hope Drive will be closed. All vehicle traffic must use the temporary access route via Southwest 16th Street. **(See the red route on the map.)**

Patient Parking & Access

- We encourage south campus patients and their visitors to use valet parking in the cancer hospital front circle, for **free** with a voucher. This is our preference to provide patients with convenient access.
- Patients and their visitors can choose to self-park across the street in the north campus east patient/visitor garage (on Newell Drive) and walk back across Archer Road to the south campus. This is also free with a voucher.
- Patients and visitors can access shuttle service at the E.R. entrance outside the valet lane.
- All other visitors pay \$10 to park in the patient/visitor garage or \$13 for valet parking.
- Emergency patients and those transporting them can use free valet parking at all our E.R. entrances.
- **Vouchers: As always, patients and their visitors must obtain a patient parking voucher after they receive care, from their outpatient check-out, nurses' station or other location of service; then present the voucher to the valet staff or parking attendant upon exit for free parking.**

Road Changes for Vehicle & Foot Traffic

- Starting Jan. 26, patients and visitors can access the south campus by entering at Circle of Hope Drive from Southwest 16th Street (by the E.R.).
- The road between the PRC Building and Rush Lake Motel site (Southwest 14th Street) will be closed.
- **No foot traffic:** Pedestrian access from Southwest 13th Street along Southwest 13th Avenue (next to the staff parking garage) will be closed during this time.
- **A staff walkway will be marked from the staff parking garage to the cancer hospital** going around the GRU Central Utility Plant and construction area (Southwest 14th Avenue). Please allow a little extra walking time.

Pedestrian Walkways

- Please follow the posted signs for safe walkways on the south campus.
- Walkways will be lit at night.
- Patients, visitors and staff can request evening/night-time escort to and from our hospitals and parking areas. Please call UF Health Shands Security Dispatch at 352-265-0109 or Student Nighttime Auxiliary Patrol (SNAP) at 352-397-7627.

Staff Parking & Access

- **Staff: Please do not use the hospital front circles and E.R. drives for staff pick-up and drop-off.**
- Staff parking will continue in the south campus staff parking garage. Staff should please access this garage from Southwest 13th Street.
- Note: Access to this garage will change during construction phases and staff may need to walk a different route across the south campus. (*See the staff parking area and the pedestrian walkway on the map.*)
